Fire Chief's Report

- Community Meetings
 - DOH/Water Association Public Forum – Meeting was well attended and the Chief's presentation appeared to be well received. Several association members asked for information on hydrant locations and for assistance in reporting water usage by the fire department during emergency incidents.
 - CERT – This orientation meeting for new and returning members was also well attended. The Chief's presentation focused on the strong support of CERT activity by the District and our desire to partner with this group in providing disaster relief.
- Ambulance status
 - Lt Drewry and Chief Schick traveled to the Braun Northwest manufacturing facility in Chehalis, WA for a pre-build conference. A few modifications were made to our original design. Our chassis' are on site and we are on their production schedule for completion dates in July and October.
- Fatality fire
 - We had a structure fire with the tragic loss of life of one individual. The fire appears to have been deliberately set resulting in severe damage to the interior of the house. Investigation of the fire was transferred to the Snohomish County Fire Marshal's office at the direction of the ICSO.
- Resource sharing with NCRFA
 - Chief John Cermak and I have been discussing potential resource sharing opportunities. We would like to establish a small discussion group consisting of Board members from each district to establish areas in which collaboration may benefit both districts.
- Strategic Plan Update
 - Staff has developed approximately 50 recommendations within the draft Strategic Plan. Each of these recommendations will be presented to the Board and other interested parties with background information as well as potential costs for discussion.
- Financial support for S1-4
 - Dean Jenkins has requested the CIFR provide financial assistance to the Support group in the amount of \$2,000 for 2016.
