Fire Chief's Report

- Community meetings
 - Tour of the SafeHarbor clinic on 10/9
 - We are exploring the potential as being a partner with the clinic in our Community Paramedicine program
 - Teleconference with Rikki King of Everett Herald on 10/6 to discuss our volunteer recruitment program and to encourage interaction between the Herald and CIFR whenever possible
 - Meeting with Stanwood Camano News on Tuesday 10/13 to discuss our new recruit program and other opportunities to get the word out about CIFR.
 - Mabana Flames
 - They are working on a "File of Life" type of program. Chief Yengoyan has been assigned to work with them on this.
 - Would like to have a procedure whereby Stn 5 could be opened during emergencies. I am still waiting for details on how this would work.
 - Madrona Jets
 - Generously donated \$500 to our CPR/Pub ED program
 - Would like to adopt our CPR program as a long-term support project
- Property Updates
 - Chief Schick sent an e-mail to the board with latest update concerning the purchase of the property to the south of the Admin Building. Ms Gilroy did contact our attorney about a possible meeting and has contacted the office to schedule another presentation.
- Labor Management Meeting
 - We expect an LOU from the labor group concerning the use of Comp Time on C shift. This will be a short term agreement and is necessary due to the impact of current staffing issues specific to that shift.
