



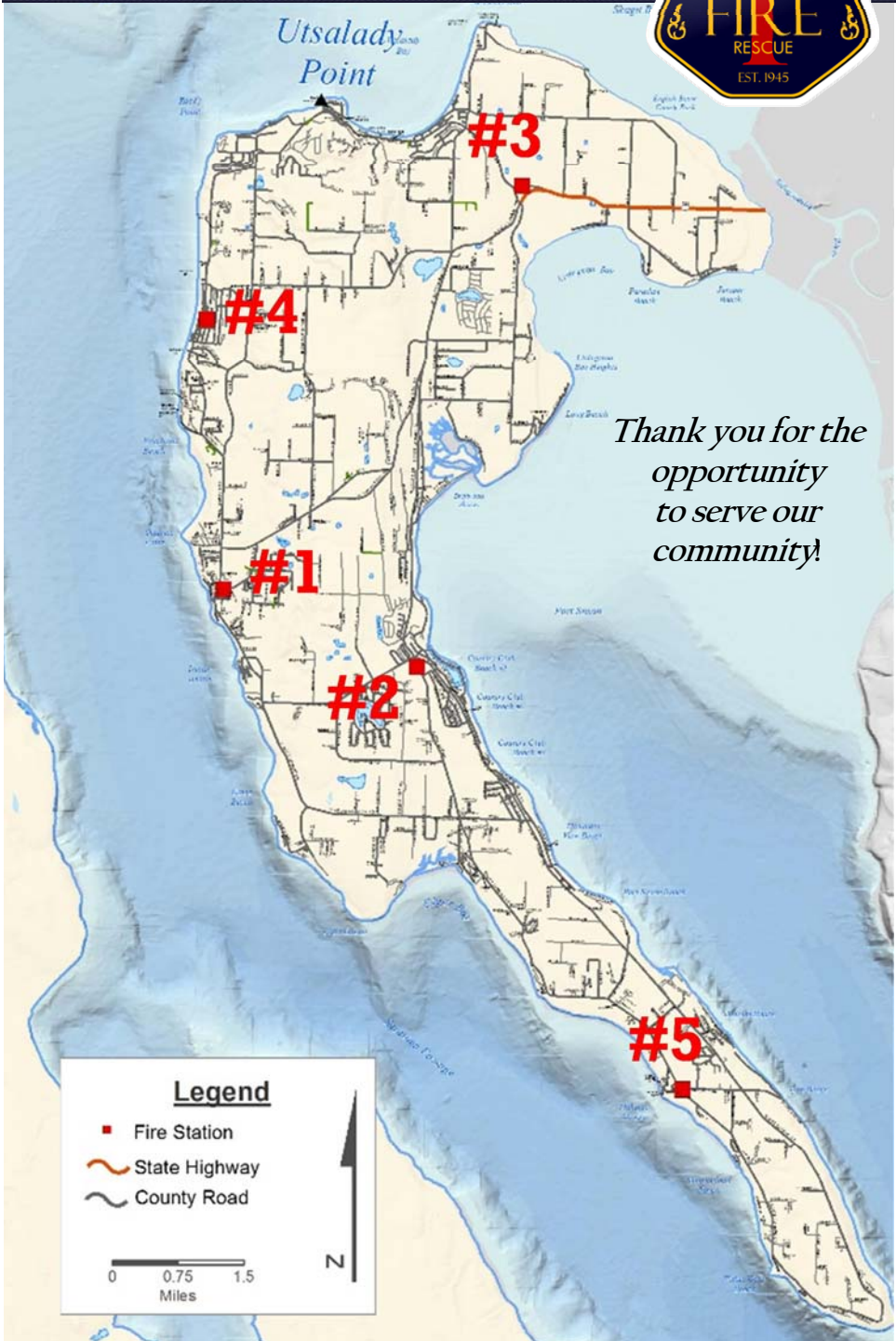
Fast Facts

Camano Island Fire & Rescue is the provider of fire, life safety and emergency medical services (EMS) for our community.

- Responded to 1,887 calls in 2016
 - Average of 1,900 calls per year
 - 73% EMS-related
- Calls increased almost 29% in five years
- Providing emergency response to 16,000 people
 - 20,000+ during the summer
 - Over 40 square miles
- 51 full-time, part-time and volunteer Firefighter/EMTs
- 10 full-time Firefighter/ Paramedics
- Funded by two property tax levies: EMS and Fire
- EMS levy renewed by voters last year at 50 cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value
- Fire levy approved by voters in 2004 at rate of \$1.25 per \$1,000
 - Levy rate has fallen to \$1.10 in 2017
 - Limited to a 1% revenue increase per year by law
 - Cost to provide service is often higher than this
- Board of Fire Commissioners asking voters to raise the fire levy to \$1.35 per \$1,000 on the November 2017 General Election ballot
 - 25-cent lid lift would cost the owner of a \$350,000 home an additional \$7.29 per month (\$87.50/year)
