Fire Chief's Report

Stats – We continue to show improvement in all areas of response times. Of particular note is our response time in the Station 5 area. A three minute drop in average response time and over a four minute drop in the 90th percentile. We only had a couple of weeks of increased staffing but I feel the impact was dramatic. With our staffing issues over the next month or so I'm not sure if we will continue to see this improvement but the officers are certainly trying.

Community presentations – I presented at the Flames monthly meeting for February. Always a pleasant experience. I'm still hearing some false rumors being generated so I was glad to correct some of the misinformation out there. Since they are a Fire Department auxiliary I gave them a quiz to see what they know about the fire department.

Labor Management February 1st – There was one item from the Labor Management group that I told them I would bring up at the Board Meeting. They requested that we develop a form to handle donations to the department. The form would have options for designating the funds to specific areas.

Personnel changes – Our part time mechanic has resigned. He will be taking over the shop for True North located in Marysville. Captain Shaughnessy has also resigned and will be the new Fire Chief for District 15.
