Chairman Williams called the regular Commissioner's meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Those in attendance were: Janice Trembl, Stephen Lich, Paul Williams, Pat Metz, Michael Schick and Darla Tiner. Commissioner Shouse was excused due to work schedule. There were 3 Crew members present. Gordon MacIvennie of VFIS and Shellie Klink of Enduris were present.

The flag salute was led by Chief Schick.

Commissioner Lich moved to approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner Metz seconded; motion carried by unanimous vote.

2017/2018 Insurance – Presentations by Shellie Klink of Enduris & Gordon MacIvennie of VFIS –

Discussion held after the two presentations. Commissioner Trembl would like the Staff to do a side by side comparison of the two insurance company's proposals and present it to the Board.

CHIEF'S REPORT – Chief Schick gave his report. The Red Cross contacted him regarding partnering on handing out smoke detectors.

Commissioner Trembl moved to accept Policy 416-Maximum Occupancy-Overcrowding, Policy 1066-Temporary Modified Duty Assignments, Policy 1093-Anti-Retaliation, as presented, Commissioner Lich seconded; motion carried by unanimous vote.

Policy 645-Firefighter Health, Safety and Survival – New policy that has gone out to the District for a 30 day review.

Harborview Paramedic School Decision – Discussion held.

Commissioner Trembl moved to withhold from sending a CIFR firefighter to Harborview Paramedic Training for the 2017/2018 term, but to place it in the District's budget for 2018 for the next term . Commissioner Metz seconded; motion carried by unanimous vote.

Union President Rooks stated that he appreciated how the Board is looking out for the needs of the District.

New Fire Truck Financing –

Commissioner Lich moved to authorize the District to finance the purchase of a new fire truck through the State's finance program. Commissioner Trembl seconded; motion carried by unanimous vote.
