Stats – Still on track for a record year. November was our second best month for response times, October was #1. I am really optimistic that we will be seeing some great improvements when our staffing models are implemented.

Community Paramedic program – There was another LTE in the SCNews last week expressing opposition to our Community Paramedic program as well as one in support.
