Vice Chairman Treml called the regular Commissioners meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. Those in attendance were: Steve Lich, Jan Treml, Erik Krieg, Jerry Evans, Levon Yengoyan, Jason Allen, Bronlea Mishler, Lisa Ernst, Dennis Wischmeier, Jerami Rathbun and Darla Tiner. There was one guest present. Chairman Williams was excused due to personal business.

The flag salute was led by Vice Chairman Treml.

<u>ICOM Director Lisa Ernst</u> – Ms. Ernst introduced herself to the Board and gave a history of her background, current status of the Dispatch Center, and plans for the future:

- They are upgrading the phone and IT systems.
- On next year's ballot, asking for increase of 1/10th of 1% increase to help fund operations/projects and to reduce the participating agencies' fees.
- Was asked what top items she would be working on that would affect CIFR:
 - o Radio communication
 - Continue the improved communication
 - Update mapping of the Island as it is different than Whidbey

Chief Yengoyan stated that, whenever a situation is brought to Ms. Ernst's attention, she always has a can—do attitude.

<u>Swear in Volunteer Emergency Worker Jerami Rathbun</u> – Jerami Rathbun was sworn in as an Volunteer Emergency Worker for CIFR by Vice Chairman Treml. FF Wischmeier gave a few words about Jerami.

<u>Public Relations Bronlea Mishler</u> – Ms. Mishler showed a power point of the proposed upgrade to the District's website. Hope to have it completed by year's end. Still working on how to archive content from the current website. New system is easily managed and will have more than one person able to manage it.

<u>PSTrax Program</u> – A/C Allen presented a power point demonstration of the new Rig Check and Controlled Substance tracking program the District is using. It is going well.

<u>Wildfire Deployment</u> – A/C Allen gave an update of District employee's deployments to California and Eastern Washington to assist in the wildland fire fighting. Some deployment pictures were shown. The Brush Truck will be paid for by the 2019 and 2020 deployments. Any Rig damages are covered by the District.
